Veritas Courses	To graduate from The College of St. Scholastica, students must complete a total of 128 credits, of which 42 need to be upper division credits and the last 32 credits must be earned through St. Scholastica. Upper division credits are those numbered 3000 or greater and cannot including graduate level credits. * Can be taken fall or spring semester. **Students who earn a Math ACT score at or above a 23 test out from this requirement.

Sixteen elective credits are required in the Finance major including a minimum of 8 credits of FIN electives and the other 8 credits can be 3000 or 4000 level FIN, ACC, CIS, ECN, MGT or MKT. It is recommended that the student choose MGT 3354 Management Ethics as one of the electives.
