It is vital that a student planning an Educational Studies major meet with an academic advisor within the School of Education as early as possible. The dedicated advisor for ALL Education Studies is John Bauman jbauman@css.edu. In addition to Veritas, requirements include:

- Students must complete EDU 1540, EDU 2210, EDU 2600, EDU 3100, and EDU 3250 (at 4 credits) as well as the Senior Capstone Internship (EDU 4777 – 4-8 credits).
- A minimum of 28 track credits determined with advisor
- Students must complete 16 credits of upper-division (numbered 3000 or greater) coursework of approved track courses

The following tracks are among the most common for Educational Studies students and are provided here for reference. Please note, however, that this major is flexible to accommodate many self-designed tracks. Potential tracks include: Business, CIS, Coaching, Corporate Training, Deaf Language and Culture, Environmental Education, Finance, Outdoor Leadership, Psychology, Religious Studies, and Social Work. What is shown below are merely examples; deviation from the example tracks may occur through advisement. In many cases, tracks closely follow minors in the associated discipline. Courses available online are marked with an *.
